Volunteer Applicants Must be:

- At least 18 years or older
- Able to work outdoors in hot or cold weather
- Available to volunteer at least one 4-hour shift per week for a minimum of 6months. Two shifts (8:30 A.M to 12:30 P.M. and 1:00 to 5:00 P.M.) are available. In exceptional circumstances, other shifts can be made available.
