- 3. Re-organizing offices and storage rooms
- 4. Cleaning and wiping windows and animal signs
- 5. Assisting in the daily cleanup duties in the Animal Kitchen

## Requirements

Volunteer Applicants Must have:

- 1. A strong commitment to advance the zoo's goals in supporting animal conservation, education and welfare.
- 2. A positive demeanor
- 3. The ability to be focused and detail oriented
- 4. A positive work ethic
- 5. Team work ability
- 6. A negative tuberculin (TB) skin test (or lung x-ray) result conducted within the last two years.

Volunteer Applicants Must be:

- 1. 18 years or above in age
- 2. Able to work outdoors in the summer heat.

3. Available to volunteer at least one 4-hour shift per week for a minimum of 6 months. Two shifts (8:30 A.M to 12:30

P.M. and 1:00 to 5:00 P.M.) are available and preferred by the Zoo Curator. In exceptional circumstances, other shifts can be made available.
