

MONARCH WAYSTATION ASSISTANCE



Micke Grove Zoo is currently accepting volunteer applications for Monarch Way Station Assistant positions. Monarch Way-station assistants will be trained to help create breeding and feeding stations for the rare monarch butterflies that migrate through California.

Towards that end, Volunteers will participate in the following activities:

- Preparing areas in the pollinator garden for planting
- Planting native plants and wildflowers
- Maintaining the pollinator garden and the native plants and wildflowers growing in it
- Adding information on each new plant to the plant mapping tool, Hortis

Volunteer Applicants must have:

- A strong commitment to advancing the zoo's goals in supporting animal conservation, education, and welfare.
- A positive demeanor
- The ability to be focused and detail-oriented
- A positive work ethic
- The ability to work in a group or individually

Volunteer Applicants Must be:

- At least 18 years or older
- Able to work outdoors in hot or cold weather
- Available to volunteer at least one 4-hour shift per week for a minimum of 6 months. Two shifts (10:00 A.M to 2:00 P.M. and 1:00 to 5:00 P.M.) are available. In exceptional circumstances, other shifts can be made available.
